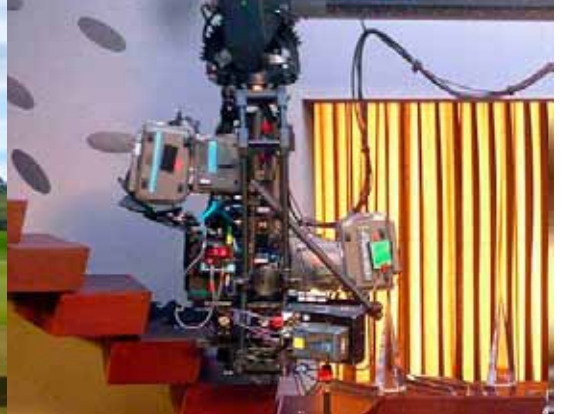
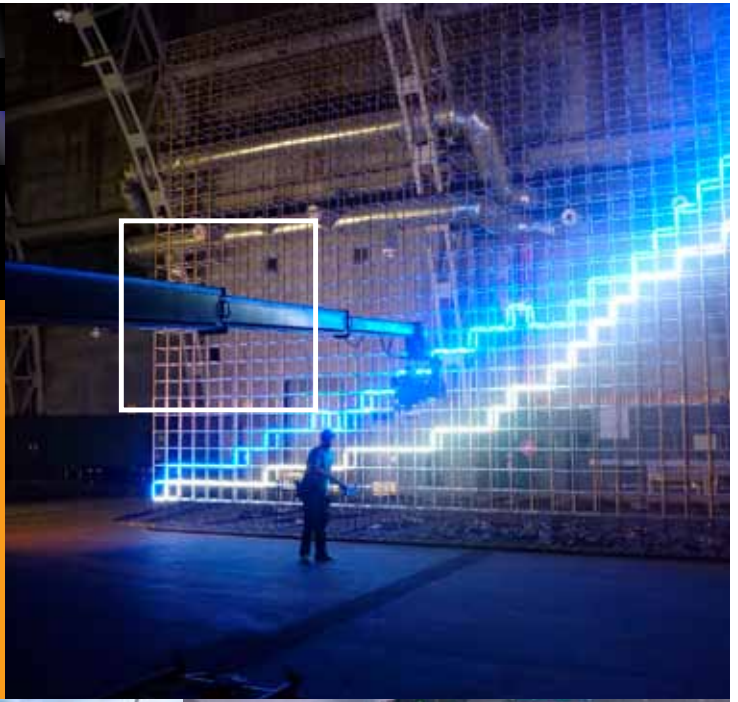

One of the beauties of the Louma2 telescopic camera crane is the automatic arc compensation or straight line. At the push of a button, Louma2 creates a two dimensional plane in virtual space. We call this planing. This is a new and exciting function of the telescopic crane adding a new tool to the grip and camera operators box of tricks. The arm automatically extends or retracts keeping the camera along the line of the plane regardless of the horizontal or vertical movement. It's possible to achieve 55 feet of straight line tracking without moving the base. Additionally, when in planing mode, automatic compensation of Smartpan, Smart Tilt or third axis roll instruction can be sent to the Louma2 remote head.
